- ☛ **United Way 2-1-1** provides people with information and referrals to community resources for human service needs. This easy-to-remember phone number is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- ☛ **United Way's Success by 6[®] Initiative** collaborates to build support for children during the formative years that influence their entire lives - from birth to age six so children are ready to succeed when they enter school.
- ☛ **Smiles Across Minnesota - Duluth** provides preventive dental services to low-income, uninsured and underinsured children ages three to twelve in the Duluth Public Elementary Schools, Middle Schools and Head Start Centers.
- ☛ **Hands On Greater Duluth**, the volunteer center of United Way, connects volunteers with opportunities. Lend a hand, visit www.unitedwayduluth.org.
- ☛ **Lake Superior Initiative**, overseen by United Way of Greater Duluth, is a three-year, federally-funded program to increase efficiency, effectiveness and capability of our region's community organizations.
- ☛ **Imagination Library**, a book program that delivers one book each month to children in our area from birth to age 5. There is no cost to the family thanks to United Way of Greater Duluth and donors who support our efforts.
