IN YOUR OWN NEIGHBORHOODS

Down the block or around the corner, there is someone in need. These are our neighbors, friends, coworkers, and family members.

A mother struggles to find a place to stay with her children to leave an abusive relationship. \$5 per week will provide three days of emergency housing for one family in Lake County. \$10.72 will house one individual at a Superior emergency shelter and provide them with food and basic hygiene items. By giving, you can help them find shelter in their community.

A brother and sister with empty stomachs get ready for school, eagerly anticipating lunch-their only meal of the day. \$1.67 per week will provide each of them with three meals per day for five days in Greater Duluth. By giving, you can guarantee they will have access to healthy food.

When someone gets laid off from a job, requires assistance filing taxes, needs a lawyer to fight an eviction, or wants dental care to keep their child's smile bright, every dollar makes a difference.

YOUR MONEY CONNECTS THE DOTS

A senior woman needs help to pay her high utility bill or it will be shut off tomorrow. A call to our 2-1-1 referral system starts a chain reaction. We find the agency that will help her keep her lights on, and we find out she also needs legal help with her landlord. We set her up with a volunteer attorney and ask if she needs food. A connection to a local food bank gives her a healthy meal.
